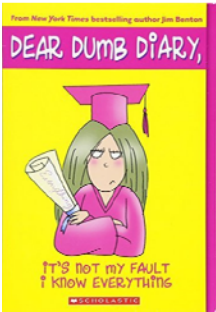

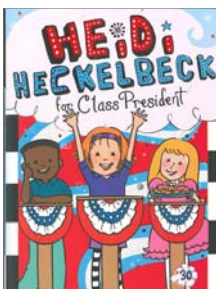


### ***Dear Dumb Diary. 8 : It's Not My Fault I Know Everything***

Sneak a peek inside the diary of Jamie Kelly, who promises that everything she writes is true... or at least as true as it needs to be.

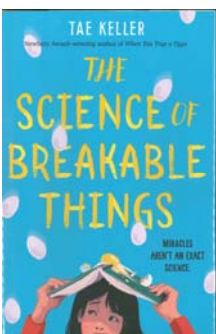


### ***Heidi Heckelbeck. 30 : Heidi Heckelbeck for Class President***

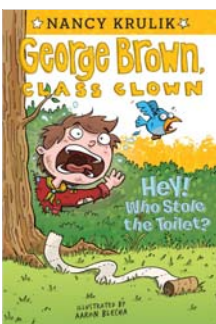


### ***The Science of Breakable Things***

Middle schooler Natalie's year-long assignment to answer a question using the scientific process leads to truths about her mother's depression and her own cultural identity.

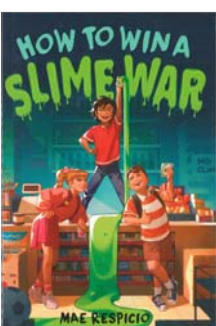


### ***George Brown, Class Clown. 8 : Hey! Who Stole the Toilet?***
