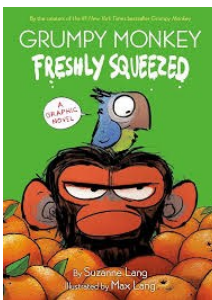

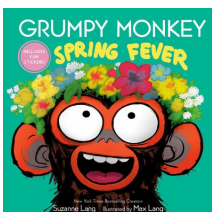

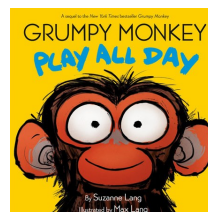
Banished to the desert after angering Oxpecker, Jim Panzee and miserable Norman decide that Jim must apologize to return home and restore their friendship.
