





Jeffers has been the recipient of numerous awards, including a New York Times Best Illustrated Children’s Books Award for *The Hueys in The New Jumper*, the Irish Book Award for *The Incredible Book Eating Boy*, and the Nestle Smarties Book Prize and the Blue Peter Book Award for *Lost and Found*.



In this salutation from Earth, the chronicler gives a tour of the planet and introduces those who call it home.


