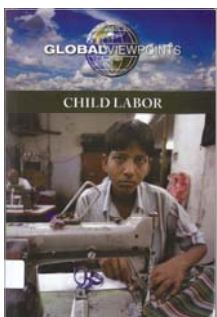

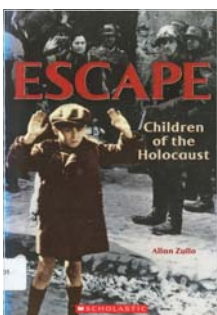

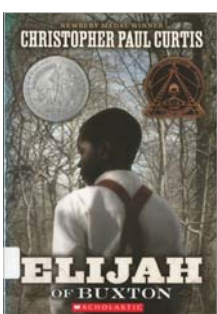


Escape : Children of the Holocaust
